- PROVIDE MAXIMAL RESOURCES
- MINIMIZE IMPACT

North-South priorities

LIMIT WARMING

- 1,5°C = enhanced action before 2020
 - Belgium not on track
- Strengthening of NDCs
 - Facilitative dialogue 2018
 - EU: -55% reduction by 2030
- Avoid false solutions
 - Forestry and land use not in carbon compensation mechanisms
- Importance of agriculture in NDCs

North-South priorities

PROVIDE MAXIMAL RESOURCES

- Pre-2020
 - Road map \$100bn
 - Concrete goals country by country
 - Belgium: keep promise (50 million) and scale up (500 million)
- Long Term Finance
 - Fair definition
 - 'Modalities of accounting': SBSTA work plan & timeline
 - Finance for Loss & Damage, more resources for WIM



MINIMIZE IMPACT

- Paris Agreement: adaptation // mitigation
 - Turn into action
 - Adaptation priority for developing countries
 - Balance & scale up finance for adaptation
 - High-level dialogue: quantitative goal for adaptation
- Loss & damage: third pillar
 - Five year work plan for WIM
 - Need for extra resources
 - \$50bn by 2020
